YWCA Banff is an innovative, non-profit organization committed to shaping a safe, inclusive community that empowers women and girls. Reporting to a Board of Directors, the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) provides leadership to a team of 40 colleagues and oversees an annual budget of \$3.5 million. The YWCA offers a full range of services including crisis response for victims of domestic and sexual violence, outreach counselling, prevention programming, and a full spectrum of housing programs including an emergency shelter and an affordable residence for approximately 200 people. The YWCA also operates a 43-room social enterprise hotel generating revenues to support day to day operations and facilities.

The Candidate

YWCA Banff is seeking a visionary, innovative Chief Executive Officer who has the passion, expertise and character to continue developing the organization. The successful candidate will be a highly motivated leader who is able to skillfully represent the organization in community; to build partnerships with agencies and businesses; to advocate on behalf of the YWCA and its constituents, and to work closely with the governance Board. In addition, the CEO must have strong fiscal acumen and business skills, advanced resource development experience, knowledge of current People and Culture practices, as well as experience with strategic planning, risk management, project planning, human services and communications at a senior level.

As leader of the YWCA, the CEO will be committed to working from an anti-oppression, feminist perspective in alignment with the guiding principles of YWCA Banff.



The ideal candidate will have a degree in human services, business, health care, or related field and /or comparable professional experience. Demonstrated fundraising expertise, non-profit experience and knowledge of the Bow Valley communities would be an asset.
