

SAGE Safe House – Housing Information

To help with finding housing, staff will meet regularly with you to discuss your housing search and provide assistance. If you have any questions, feel free to discuss them with staff.

Choosing the types of housing:

- **Seniors Subsidized apartments**
 - Independent living, in a private apartment
- **Lodge**
 - Independent living with meals provided
- **Designated Assisted Living & other Assisted Living**
 - Alberta Health Services Home Care will assess level of care based on discussions with the senior & assist in applying for housing
- **Private rental**
 - EX: Boardwalk Apartments, Main Street Apartments, list of rentals available through Boyle Street Coop, Edmonton Journal classifieds.

Things to consider in Seniors' Subsidized apartments:

- most accept applications for aged 65+
- some do not allow smoking, or have a limited number of smoking suites
- some have limited parking
- bachelor suites usually rented to singles, one bedroom suites usually reserved for couples
- most do not allow pets
- Rent is 30% of your income

Other considerations:

- Budget
- Area of the city / out of town
- Access to grocery stores, services provided in the building, etc.
- What compromises am I willing to make?

Applying:

- Seniors apartment buildings & lodges require the following:
 - **Notice Of Assessment, from your income taxes.**
 - If you do not have your taxes done, let staff know right away and they can assist in completing your income taxes
