Position Overview

As a **Residential Outreach Worker**, you will be responsible for supporting residents in moving forward successfully from Emergency Shelter services. You will provide consistent in-home, one on one support, education, advocacy, safety planning and community referrals with the goal of empowering women to live with safety and wellbeing while maintaining stable housing/tenancy.

As a Residential Outreach Worker, you will:

- Develop an active caseload and ensure effective case management, including evaluation of clients' progress with identified goals.
- Support client in developing knowledge and skills for successful tenancy through consistent education, programming and one-on-one support.
- Assist clients in maintaining successful tenancy through assessment and support of client needs: safety, emotional support, legal, basic needs, health, family violence education, etc.
- Assess the risk and vulnerability of the individual and respond with appropriate risk management strategies, adhering to LIHS policies and procedures.
- Provide comprehensive safety planning and trauma-informed care to clients, as well as harm reduction strategies for interpersonal and/or family violence, substance use, mental health and sexual health, etc.
- Advocate for social justice and reduce barriers to women accessing services.
- Participate and organize client network meetings internally and with other appropriate community agencies.
- Establish relationships with other community agencies and groups to assist with client support.
- Develop and facilitate tenancy success programming in addition to established Residential programming.
- Contribute to the day-to-day operations of the Emergency Shelter.
- General facility housekeeping, maintenance, and organization.
